Anyone Making Babies Out There?

Someone sent me a link to <billboard.com>. Under the title, "Bonnaroo Day 4 Recap: Florence + the Machine Dazzles, Billy Joel Closes Out Fest," by Chris Payne and Dominick Grillo (dated June 15, 2015 4:05 AM EDT) there is an every-few-minutes' posting of events that occurred on the last day of Bonnaroo. Below are a few.

1:50 PM: "My favorite thing about writing songs is writing about the ... [slang word for copulation] things you do and watching people dance to them," notes Jessica Hernandez of her namesake outfit, *Jessica Hernandez and the Deltas*. So, what did you do, Jessica? "This song's called 'Sorry I Stole Your Man.'" Ah, right.

1:54 PM: Hernandez seems to have a pretty good idea of the kind of folk who come to 'Roo: "This song is dedicated to all of you weird people at Bonnaroo because I know you're getting into some weird stuff... This song's called 'Carnie Threesome'."

3:45 PM: Nothing like an old Appalachian coal mining song to help test the political climate of a crowd of people. With Béla Fleck and Abigail Washburn performing "Come all Ye Coal Miners," the audience roars with delight at the repeated refrain "Let's sink this capitalist system."

9:10 PM: [Billy] Joel gasps, "Some of you have been here for three days, huh?" (virtually the entire crowd was on its fourth). Being the narrative-inclined 66-year old he is, he compared it to Woodstock: "I didn't play; I was just there. I guess this is what it was like.... Anyone making babies out there?"

10:45 PM: A rousing performance of "Only the Good Die Young" appears to cap Joel's encore. "Don't drink and drive!" he yells coming offstage, referencing his own rocky past. "Do what I do -- drink and get a big limousine."

At various times during Manchester's pride and joy, one could look to the skies and see an airplane pulling a banner advertising a famous brand of prophylactic. This doesn't even touch the hem of the garment.

Most of the performers used vile language. Ms. Hernandez dedicated one song to "weird people at Bonnaroo," saying, → P. 3. Col. 2

"I know you're into some weird stuff." She salutes their weirdness with a song about three-party fornication. The audience, we're told roared at hearing Béla Fleck and Abigail Washburn repeatedly sing, "Let's sink this capitalist system." Perhaps somebody who knows somebody could ask the Bonnaroo folks if Fleck and Washburn performed for free. Billy Joel advised the audience against drinking and driving, telling them to do what he does: "Drink and get a big limousine." I suppose he has no fear of sinking with the capitalist system. Too, Mr. Joel compared Bonnaroo to Woodstock; he said, "I guess this is what it was like..." and asked, "Anyone making babies out there?"

I am not mentioning any of this for shock value, or for information. People know what goes on there. It is what it is: a borderline orgy largely characterized by five of the "works of the flesh" cited by the Spirit of God: "fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness...drunkenness [and] revelings" (Galatians 5:19-21). It's what all this means about societal decay that makes me sad. I have no respect for people who shake their heads, yet aver that it's all good for the economy. I have disdain for performers who enrich themselves decrying the capitalist system. One's contempt is not so much stirred by performers and producers. They are doing what comes naturally. What is most galling, though, is the blatant hypocrisy of some people who profess to be followers of Jesus. What does Jesus say about such things as mentioned above?

Or know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with men, nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God. And such were some of you: but ye were washed, but ye were sanctified, but ye were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, and in the Spirit of our God. ... the body is not for fornication, but for the Lord; and the Lord for the body: and God both raised the Lord, and will raise up as through his power. ...Flee fornication. →

Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that committeth fornication sinneth against his own body. Or know ye not that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit which is in you, which ye have from God? and ye are not your own; for ye were bought with a price: glorify God therefore in your body. (1 Corinthians 6:9-20)

Be not unequally yoked with unbelievers: for what fellowship have righteousness and iniquity? or what communion hath light with darkness? And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what portion hath a believer with an unbeliever? And what agreement hath a temple of God with idols? for we are a temple of the living God; even as God said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. Wherefore Come ye out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, And touch no unclean thing; And I will receive you, And will be to you a Father, And ye shall be to me sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty. (2 Corinthians 6:14-18)

...But fornication, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, let it not even be named among you, as becometh saints; nor filthiness, nor foolish talking, or jesting, which are not befitting: but rather giving of thanks. For this ye know of a surety, that no fornicator, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God. ...(Eph 5:1-13)

How would Jesus or the Holy Spirit characterize the things described on page one? Even though such things are “not even [to] be named among [us] as becometh saints,” there are Christians who were there. They communed with “darkness” and “Belial” and some even made it to church where they ate the Lord’s Supper and sang “Amazing Grace,” and “Trust and Obey.”

Feigned profession is nothing new. “Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye tithe mint and anise and cummin, and have left undone the weightier matters of the law, justice, and mercy, and faith: but these ye ought to have done, and not to have left the other undone” (Matthew 23:23). Put a Christian touch to some of the terms, and this is precisely how the Lord Jesus Christ views Christian claimants who spent any of their time and dollars at Bonnaroo. — aa
